Fine Arts Curriculum

FA.AK:1 Students will investigate and explore the elements of art. (IL 25A, NS 1)

- FA.AK:1-1 Identify the colors: red, yellow, blue, green, purple, orange, black, white and brown.
- FA.AK:1-2 Recognize primary colors.
- FA.AK:1-3 Experiment with color mixing.
- FA.AK:1-4 Demonstrate an awareness that textures exist and that objects may feel different from each other.
- FA.AK:1-5 Identify and draw a square, rectangle, circle, oval and triangle.
- FA.AK:1-6 Identify and draw a variety of lines.
- FA.AK:1-7 Create a 3-dimensional form.
- FA.AK:1-8 Overlapping and size relation.
- FA.AK:1-9 Represent people and objects with symbols.

FA.AK:2 Students will investigate and explore principles of art. (IL 25B, NS 4, NS 5, NS6)

- FA.AK:2-1 Create a visual image with symmetry.
- FA.AK:2-2 Recognize a pattern.
- FA.AK:2-3 Use repetition to create a pattern.
- FA.AK:2-4 Recognize the main idea in works of visual art.

FA.AK:3 Students will employ introductory skills to produce visual works of art using a variety of tools and media. (IL 26A, IL 26B, NS 1, NS 2, NS 3)

- FA.AK:3-1 Identify and use basic drawing tools in a responsible manner.
- FA.AK:3-2 Create an age appropriate drawing.
- FA.AK:3-3 Identify and use basic painting tools in a responsible manner.
